Δ-7 FORENSIC HISTOPATHOLOGY: TRAINING AND PRACTICE IN THE UK.

Training in Forensic Pathology varies around the world and could be broadly divided into two major schools of thought in part tailored to local practices. The general approach to training, its length and the integration of full histology training would appear to be some of the striking differences. In the UK Forensic Histopathology training is regulated by the General Medical Council and the Royal College of Pathologists and is aimed to produce consultants able to practice independently whilst still maintaining strong links with local pathology departments. This talk will explore the training curriculum in the UK and provide a number of examples to illustrate the importance of the use and reporting of histology by the practicing forensic pathologist.
